****Subsidy for female players residing in Vaudreuil-Dorion (born after June 15, 2008), if a minor at the time of registration. The subsidy will be reimbursed to the credit card on file once received from the city and will not be credited at the time of registration. The citizen card must be valid.**

Valleyfield Residents: The City subsidy is currently pending approval. The amount will be credited to the credit card on file as soon as it is received.

***Residents of other cities:** Base Fee - Primary residence of the player without direct subsidy from a city. **Les Cèdres Residents:** The \$100 subsidy will be reimbursed when received, as the city offers only ONE subsidy per calendar year across all activities combined; it is therefore not guaranteed that this subsidy will be received.

➤ **New:** HQ has added a questionnaire for Physio services (player health and insurance purchase). You may refuse this service but must still answer the questionnaire.

Residents of Vaudreuil-Dorion and Valleyfield: Please ensure that the citizen card in the player's name is valid before proceeding with registration and have it on hand, as you

will need to provide the card number, address, and expiration date. Note that the card must be renewed if it expires before the end of the year to benefit from the subsidy.

Mandatory for new members only: After creating the profile, please send us or upload the following documents directly into the child's HCR profile:

- Two proofs of residence of the child's primary residence (copy of municipal or school tax bill, electricity bill, landline telephone bill, residential television or internet bill)
- Copy of the child's birth certificate

Failure to provide these documents within 48 hours of registration will result in the registration not being confirmed, and the child will not be allowed to participate in any on-ice activities until the documents are provided. Failure to provide the documents may lead to the cancellation of the registration.

M7 PROGRAM (2022 to 2020) Additional Information:

M7: Sessions 2 times per week, Saturdays/Sundays, starting September 26, 2026 (in the morning). An information meeting for M7 parents will take place in September; details to follow.

Players born in 2022 must be always accompanied on the ice by an adult during hockey learning sessions. The adult accompanying the player must wear a hockey helmet and hockey gloves; a hockey stick is highly recommended.

PAYMENT (see fees above)

The payment of registration fees can be split into three installments due as follows:

- First installment equal to 50% of the total registration fees at the time of registration on the Hockey Canada platform;
- A second installment equal to 25% of the total registration fees as of September 1, 2026;
- A third installment equal to 25% of the total registration fees as of October 1, 2026.

Payments will be automatically debited on the dates mentioned above from the credit card you provided on file. **You must update your credit card information in your Spordle account** to ensure all installments are accepted, including in the event of a new card or a change in the expiration date. **For any refused or declined payment on the credit card, a \$40 fee will automatically be charged to you.** The only accepted method of payment for registration fees is by credit card.

REFUND POLICY:

Withdrawal before September 1st (all levels)

In the event of a player's withdrawal, only withdrawals occurring and notified to the Registrar and the Association (in writing to registrairestorm@gmail.com) **BEFORE** September 1, 2026, will be eligible for a full refund of registration fees minus a \$50 administration fee.

After this date, refunds will be determined based on the following conditions:

Withdrawal: All levels, except M7

- If the withdrawal occurs between September 1st and September 30th of the current year, please note that a **\$250 fee is non-refundable** and will be withheld from the refund. From the moment a player participates in any sporting activity offered by the AHMFSO (Storm), membership fees for the Hockey Québec, Hockey Canada, and Hockey Lac St-Louis federations are no longer refundable.
- As of **October 1, 2026**, no refund for any reason whatsoever will be accepted, considered, calculated, or issued, except for a withdrawal due to injury upon presentation of a doctor's note. In this case, refer to the clause for withdrawal due to injury (all levels).

Withdrawal : M7 Levels

- If the withdrawal occurs between September 1st and October 31st of the current year, please note that a **\$150 fee is non-refundable** and will be withheld from the refund. From the moment a player participates in any sporting activity offered by the AHMFSO (Storm), membership fees for the Hockey Québec, Hockey Canada, and Hockey Lac St-Louis federations are no longer refundable.
- As of **November 1, 2026**, no refund for any reason whatsoever will be accepted, considered, calculated, or issued, except for a withdrawal due to injury upon presentation of a doctor's note. In this case, refer to the clause for withdrawal due to injury (all levels).

Withdrawal due to injury (all levels)

Only a withdrawal due to injury may be subject to a partial refund after the dates mentioned above depending on the level, and this, only until **December 31, 2026**. To obtain a partial refund, an official doctor's note must be submitted. In addition to the \$250 amount that will be withheld as specified above (\$150 for M7 players), a \$50 administration fee as well as ice fees prorated to the sessions offered to the player as of the date of the injury (and not based on the player's attendance at the sessions) will also be withheld.

Withdrawal for School Hockey

A voluntary or involuntary departure, including the registration of your child in school hockey that does not allow dual registration, is considered a withdrawal under the terms of the refund policy.

M22 (Junior) Single Letter Camp

A selection process may be put in place if we have too many players for the number of teams to be determined in September. Players who are not selected will receive a refund of their registration fees minus a \$175 fee to cover AHMFSO (Storm) expenses.

Consumer Protection Act

PARENTAL CONTRIBUTION

By registering my child, I understand that in addition to the registration fees mentioned above, I must pay a parental contribution ranging approximately between **\$250 and \$400** to my child's team budget (note that this contribution is higher for members of

double-letter teams). This parental contribution is **MANDATORY** and is determined jointly by the coach and the team manager at the beginning of the season. I also understand that by registering my child above, I commit to her participation in tournaments, development sessions, extra practices, and fundraising campaigns organized by my child's team, which activities are themselves part of the team budget.

For players registered in the M7 category, there is no parental contribution.

PLAYER POSITION AND NO TEAM GUARANTEE

By proceeding with my child's registration, I understand that my child's position is requested solely to identify the number of goaltenders available at the start of the season. Under no circumstances does the Association commit to playing my child at a position I have voluntarily identified, given that the Association's policy is player development.

It is also understood that the Association at no time guarantees that my child will play at any specific level, on a particular team, or with certain teammates, even if I make an express written request.

CODE OF CONDUCT and CODE OF ETHICS:

By agreeing to register your child in South-West girls' minor hockey activities, you commit to signing and obtaining the signature, if applicable, of the other parent and your child, on the code of conduct and code of ethics that will be given to you at the start of the season.

These codes of conduct and ethics are absolute prerequisites for your child's presence on the ice.

Failure on your part to sign and obtain the signature of the other parent and your child for each of the codes of conduct and ethics will result in your child being unable to participate in AHMFSO hockey activities, without you being eligible in any way for a refund of registration fees or compensation.

Registration for a Try-outs Activity

A player who registers for a try-out's activity (AAA, AA tryout camp, and registration for the season in an AHM or a Fusion/Regroupement) must continue the entire season within the network to which the activity is subject, namely the mix program or female program, without the possibility of transferring to the other network at any time before and during the season. It is strictly forbidden for a player to register for 2 selection activities. Furthermore, a player must register for the camp tied to the network where she intends to play for the remainder of the season.
